“ *Paul was truly a person who they broke the mold after making. He was strong as an ox and yet, when he laughed, it was with the truth of a child. In fact, whenever Paul laughed out loud, he had this little high-pitched giggle that would come out. It's the same way he laughed when he was 9 years old. And it was always honest. That's what he was. And he was just too young to be gone already. It's heart-breaking. 153 people came out to his viewing on Thursday night. And 75 people came to his funeral on Friday. The car train was 2 blocks long. I've been to a lot of funerals, where the people were 50 strong at the viewing and 30 at the funeral. But I have never seen a turn out like Paul had. That tells you everything you ever need to know about Paul. He loved people and people loved him. People from every age group. Anyone can make you feel like crap, but Paul, he made you feel like you were not alone, fully supported, and felt great about yourself. A man who's body was like steel, and yet I saw him hold a kitten with complete tenderness. He is a legend, and there will never be another one like him. I'm his uncle Felix. To all the people who came out, we consider you close friends of our family. Paul, I love you and I'll never stop thinking about you.*
