Don McNeil Norris was born on May 13, 1954 in Saluda, South Carolina. After a brief illness, Don departed this life on March 17, 2013 at Penn Hospice at Rittenhouse in Phila. PA. He was the third child born to Sara Elease Norris and late Luther Norris.

Don accepted Christ at an early age. He grew up in a spiritual family unit, attending Mennonite, Methodist, and Catholic churches.

Don was educated and graduated from the Montgomery County, Norristown, PA. school district

Don enlisted in the Army in 1976. He was a sergeant and a 31M20 multichannel communications equipment operator for 4 years. While serving his country, he was awarded the Good Conduct Medal, Expert Hand Grenade Award and the Sharpshooter award for the rifle. Don was honorably discharged in 1981.

Don was employed by the US Postal Service until his retirement in early 2000. After retirement, he became a chauffeur for a local limousine and transportation service.
